## Detailed description

### Life in extreme locations

The Große Walsertal can officially call itself a biosphere reserve, which indicates a high quality of life. For centuries, the population has had to strategically solve a variety of problems in order to survive. The inhabitants are still exposed to geographical, economic and social extremes that differ from other regions. What developments have taken place in the Großes Walsertal? What are the prospects for people living in the Großes Walsertal today? The exhibition and themed tour at the Museum Großes Walsertal are dedicated to this interesting field of tension, from the colonisation of the valley to the present day.

### The Museum

The imposing semi-detached house in the centre of Sonntag is a piece of history in itself. Over the centuries it has served as a home, a dairy, a bakery and an inn. Since 1981, the house has housed a museum. Today, the museum building and stables are owned by the six municipalities in the valley. The museum is run by the Großes Walsertal Heimatverein. The extensive museum work is carried out by interested members of the society on a voluntary basis.
